Christoph Meyer, born in Württemberg, Germany, is the father of Gottlieb Mayer. His oldest three children—Louisa, Emma, and Mathias ("Max")—retained the Meyer spelling of their surname, but Gottlieb (who was 15 years younger than Louisa) changed his name to Mayer. Christoph Meyer's wife, Marie Margareta Eberhart, lived nearly 20 more years, dying on 5 Sep. 1925.
