Nov. 14, 1940

Karl Vogt, husband of Margery Mayer's older sister Ethel, was born in Germany on Nov. 20, 1909 and emigrated to the United States when he was 20 years old. He married Ethel on June 29, 1937. Three years later, on the eve of WW II, he became a United States citizen. The following image of his naturalization record is from the US Naturalization Record Indexes, 1791-1992.
